APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Motion was made by Member Soza and seconded by Member Brown approving the April 4, 2018, Transportation Board meeting minutes as presented.

Motion carried unanimously, with Member Ayala abstaining.

DISCUSSION CALENDAR

SPEED LIMIT ZONE ESTABLISHMENT – BERRY ROAD

Following discussion motion was made by Member Brown and seconded by Vice Chair Armas recommending that the Transportation Board recommend that the City Council adopt an ordinance to establish a 35 MPH speed limit zone on Berry Road from Trautwein Road to Crystal View Terrace.

Motion carried unanimously.

ESTABLISHMENT OF AXLE RESTRICTION – SEGMENT OF SYCAMORE CANYON BOULEVARD

Following discussion motion was made by Member Soza and seconded by Member Bullock recommending that the Transportation Board recommend that the City Council approve establishment of an axle restriction prohibiting use by commercial vehicles exceeding three axles on Sycamore Canyon Boulevard from Fair Isle Drive to Central Avenue.

Motion carried unanimously.
