

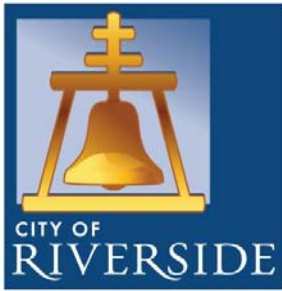

<u>PLANNING CASE P18-0843 – CONTINUANCE - REVOCATION MINOR CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT (CU-024-978) - CAFÉ SEVILLA RESTAURANT, 3252 MISSION INN AVENUE, WARD 2</u> Proposal by the City of Riverside to consider a partial revocation of Planning Cases CU-024-978 (Minor Conditional Use Permit) and P03-1166 (Revised Minor Conditional Use Permit) to revoke the nightclub and rooftop uses (including entertainment) at Café Sevilla Restaurant. Chair Rossouw announced that the applicant has requested a continuance. Nathan Heyde, attorney, Varner & Brandt, stated they would like to request continuance to provide additional time to meet with city staff. There were no comments from the audience regarding the continuance.
