PUBLIC PARKING PROGRAM IMPROVEMENT AND FUNDING OPTIONS TO MAXIMIZE EXISTING INVENTORY CAPACITY

Following discussion, motion was made by Councilmember Gardner and seconded by Vice Chair Mac Arthur to (1) receive and order filed the report on public parking program improvements and funding options to maximize existing parking inventory capacity and forward to the Budget Engagement Commission and/or City Council for consideration; and (2) direct the Public Works Department to return within 12 months to the City Council Transportation Committee with an update on parking solutions and an analysis of the alternate parking program initiatives to (a) extend the hours of operation in the parking garages; and (b) implement a demand responsive rate structure in the parking garages. Motion carried with Chair Soubirous voting "No".
