MINUTES

Chair Perry called the meeting to order at 1 p.m.

MASSAGE BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENT REGULATIONS

Following discussion, motion was made by Member Adams and seconded by Member Melendrez recommending that the City Council adopt an ordinance amending Chapter 5.52 of the Riverside Municipal Code regarding massage businesses to allow suspension of a massage establishment permit as an alternative form of discipline and provide for an appeal process heard by an independent Administrative Hearing Officer rather than the Public Safety Committee. Motion carried unanimously.

PLANNING CASE - PSP19-0030 - MOBILE RECYCLING FACILITIES

Following discussion, motion was made by Chair Perry and seconded by Member Adams recommending that the City Council amend Riverside Municipal Code Title 19 to (1) clarify screening requirements to include exterior architectural treatment/cladding to enhance the appearance of recycling units (e.g., cargo containers) to be consistent with the architecture of the buildings on site; (2) specify that the recycling center operator and property owner shall be responsible for the daily retrieval and removal of any shopping cart left within 100 feet of the recycling units and daily litter removal; (3) prohibit facilities from locating in service areas behind buildings when adjacent to residential uses and/or increasing setback requirements from residentially zoned properties; and (4) require renewal of permits every two years for ongoing review and compliance with permit conditions and allow for changes to the facility when site conditions change. Motion carried unanimously.
