DENIAL OF VEHICLE FOR HIRE PERMIT APPLICATION - APPEAL - ERIC WYNN

Following discussion, motion was made by Chair Perry and seconded by Vice Chair Melendrez to deny the appeal by Eric Wynn and uphold the Police Chief's denial of a Vehicle for Hire Permit Application based on the evidence presented.

The denial is based on Section 5.40.180(d)(4) of the Riverside Municipal Code and specifically, on the grounds that the applicant or driver's permit holder has falsified, misrepresented, or omitted pertinent information in the application.

Motion carried unanimously.

The decision of the Public Safety Committee is final with no further right of appeal to the City Council. Because there is no provision for reconsideration of the decision, or for a written decision or written findings supporting the decision in any applicable provision of any statute, charter, or rule, this decision is final today. You may seek judicial review of this decision pursuant to California Code of Civil Procedure, section 1094.5 by filing a petition with the Riverside County Superior Court. The time within which judicial review must be sought is governed by Section 1094.6.
