NO SOLICITING AND CUSTOM NO PANHANDLING SIGNS AT SELECT FREEWAY EXIT RAMP AND INTERSECTIONS TO EDUCATE AND INCREASE PEDESTRIAN SAFETY AWARENESS

Following discussion, it was moved by Vice-Chair Perry and seconded by Member Hemenway to (1) receive and order filed the update on signage and practices to reduce pedestrian safety concerns at freeway exit ramps; (2) approve the installation of additional standard No Soliciting signs at select freeway exit ramps visible to motorists and solicitors; and (3) direct staff to pursue approval from the California Traffic Control Device Committee for custom "No Panhandling" signs within the City. The motion carried unanimously.
