2020 CALIFORNIA HOUSING BILLS UPDATE

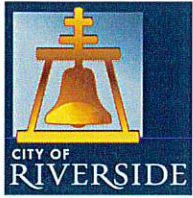
Following discussion and without formal motion, the Committee unanimously received and ordered filed an update on the 2020 California Housing Bills.

GRANT APPLICATION TO STATE OF CALIFORNIA FOR HOMELESS HOUSING, ASSISTANCE AND PREVENTION PROGRAM ROUND 2 FUNDING FOR \$3,262,879 TO PROVIDE HOMELESS AND HOUSING SERVICES

Following discussion, it was moved by Vice-Chair Melendrez and seconded by Member Plascencia to (1) direct staff to look for work force development programs for the grant application to the State of California for the Homeless Housing, Assistance and Prevention Program Round 2 funding in the amount of \$3,262,879 to provide homeless and housing services in the City of Riverside; (2) recommend that the City Council authorize submission of the grant application to the State of California for the Homeless Housing, Assistance and Prevention Program Round 2 funding in the amount of \$3,262,879 to provide homeless and housing services in the City of Riverside; and (3) authorize the City Manager, or his designee, to execute all grant documents related to the Homeless Housing, Assistance and Prevention Program Round 2 funding in the amount of \$3,262,879, including making non-substantive changes. The motion carried unanimously.
