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#### PUBLIC HEARINGS

PLANNING CASE PR-2020-000144 – CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT AND DESIGN REVIEW - 4700 CANYON CREST DRIVE, WARD 2

Proposal by Christopher Kassaseya of St. Andrew Orthodox Christian Church to consider the following entitlements: 1) Modification of a previously approved Conditional Use Permit (Planning Case P08-0046) to permit a 6,116 square foot church hall expansion, construct a 4,104 square foot administration building, and to demolish and reconstruct a portion of the west parking lot; and 2) Design Review of project plans. Judy Egüez, Associate Planner, presented the staff report. Catherine George, on behalf of St. Andrew Orthodox Church, accepted the conditions of approval.

Chair Kirby experienced technical difficulties and exited the meeting. Vice-Chair Teunissen presided. She asked if there were any callers for this proposal, there were none. The public hearing was closed.

Following discussion it was moved by Commissioner Roberts and seconded by Commissioner Ridgway to: 1) Determine that the project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 15332 (In-Fill Development Projects) of the CEQA Guidelines, as the project will not have a significant effect on the environment; and 2) Approve Planning Case PR-2020-000144 (Conditional Use Permit and Design Review) based on the findings outlined in the staff report and subject to the recommended conditions.

Chair Kirby returned to the meeting.

Vice-Chair Teunissen advised of the appeal period.

The Planning Commission decision is final unless appealed to City Council.
