UPDATES FROM THE CITY MANAGER'S OFFICE

Interim Assistant City Manager/CFO/City Treasurer Edward Enriquez reported the following City Council items associated with RPD:

June 28, 2022:

Resolution offering a reward in the amount of \$10,000 for information leading to the identity and apprehension of the person or persons responsible for the recent home invasion robberies.

Edward also gave the 1st 2022 Quarterly Update related to CPRC Communications:

During the period of January through March 2022, the CPRC Office received 14 phone calls. Of those calls, ten were related to Riverside Police department and three other law enforcement agencies. Disposition of those calls resulted in four citizen complaint submissions.
