2022 SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY, ENGINEERING, AND MATHEMATICS (STEM) - PUBLIC UTILITIES LEARNING LAB (PULL) EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM UPDATE

Following discussion and without formal motion, the Board of Public Utilities received and ordered filed the update on the Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (STEM) Public Utilities Learning Lab (PULL) educational program and recognized the First, Second, and Third place winners of the 2022 Week of STEM-PULL.

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DISCUSSION CALENDAR

BID RPU-7916 - WORK ORDER 1910967 - DESIGN, CONSTRUCTION, CONSTRUCTION SUPPORT, CONTRACT ADMINISTRATION, INSPECTION, AND CONSTRUCTION CHANGE ORDER AUTHORITY COSTS - GIBRALTAR DRIVE CABLE REPLACEMENT PROJECT

Following discussion, it was moved by Vice Chair Goldware and seconded by Member Oceguera to (1) award Bid RPU-7916 for the Gibraltar Drive Cable Replacement Project to E.E. Electric, Inc., Jurupa Valley, in the amount of \$348,754.25; (2) approve the capital expenditure for Work Order 1910967 in the amount of \$509,000, which includes design, construction, construction support, contract administration, inspection, and construction change order authority costs for the Gibraltar Drive Cable Replacement Project; and (3) authorize the City Manager, or designee, to execute any documents necessary to effectuate the project as outlined in the staff report, as well as the ability to make minor non-substantive changes in alignment with all purchasing policies. The motion carried with Chair Crohn, Vice Chair Goldware, and Members Heru, Melendez, Montgomery, and Oceguera voting aye, Member Wohlgemuth voting no, and Member Gujral absent.

PUBLIC UTILITIES' ELECTRIC AND WATER RATE TRENDS STUDIES UPDATE

Following discussion, it was moved by Member Oceguera and seconded by Member Wohlgemuth to receive and order filed the update on Riverside Public Utilities' Electric and Water Rate Trends Studies. The motion carried unanimously with Member Gujral absent.
