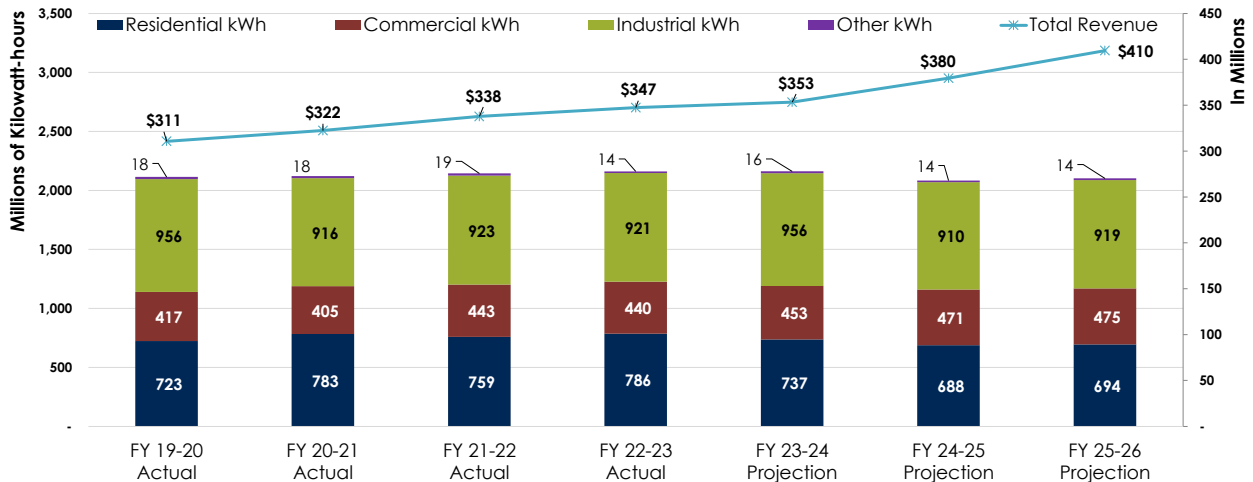

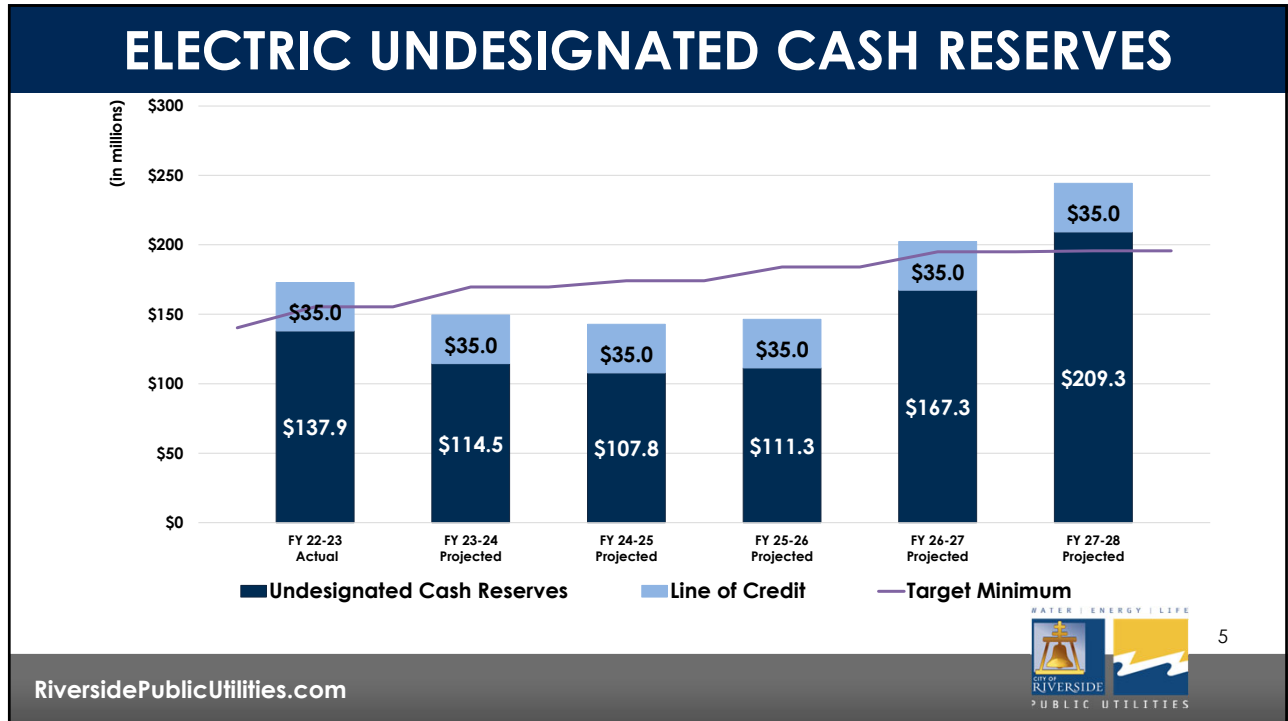
# ELECTRIC RETAIL KWH SALES AND REVENUE



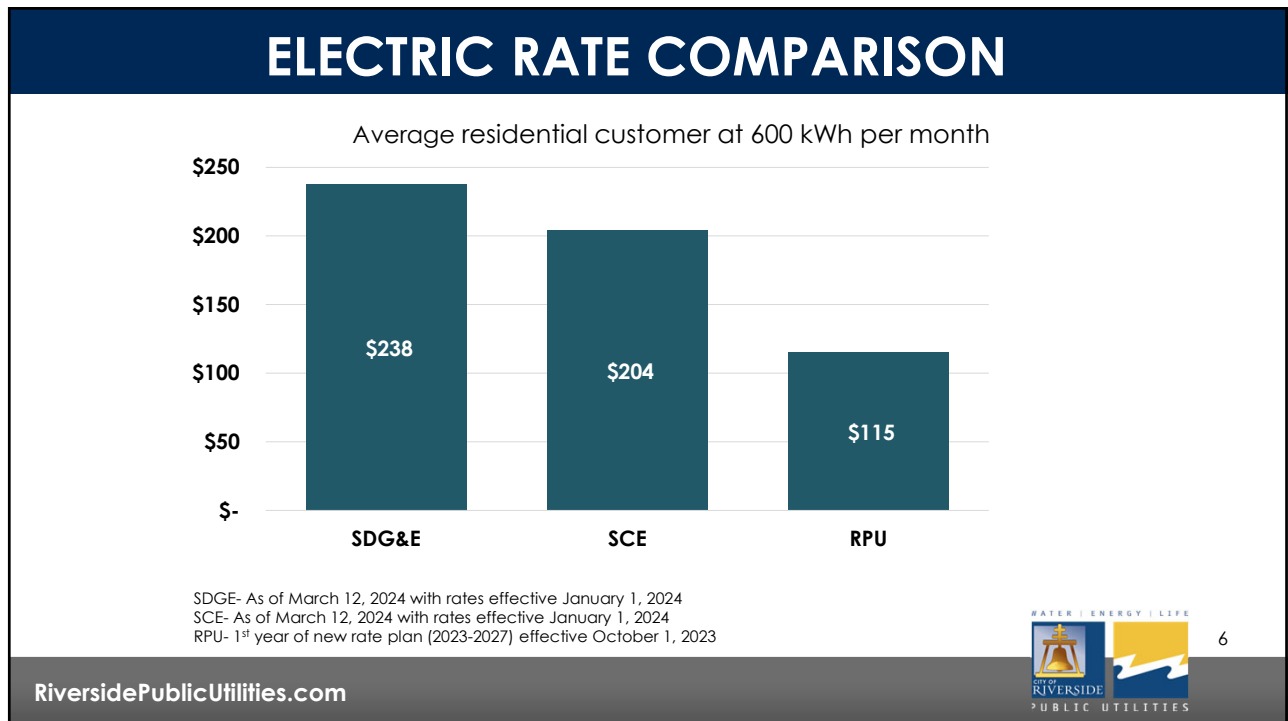
