As of March 3, 2026, Kristina Gordon was appointed and sworn in as a Citywide Commissioner. With this recent appointment, the Commission currently has thirteen filled seats out of the fifteen authorized positions. Two vacancies currently remain on the Commission, representing Ward 3 and Ward 7. The Ward 3 vacancy occurred on January 27, 2026, and five applications currently on file have been forwarded to Councilmember Robillard for review. The Ward 7 vacancy occurred on August 19, 2025, and the five applications on file have been forwarded to Councilmember Hemenway for review.
