BACKGROUND

- 1. On May 23, 1961, a Final Order of Condemnation was hereby ordered, adjudged and decreed in favor of the City for the Riverside Water Company. This included Assessor's Parcel Number 225-350-070.
- 2. August 1, 2013, City entered into a license agreement with Cole LA Riverside, LP, which allowed the Licensee to cross over the canal to access their parking.

DISCUSSION

- 1. The Canal was formerly used for conducting, supplying, and distributing irrigation water to and for the use of the city.
- 2. The canal is currently used for the operation and maintenance of an underground irrigation pipeline.
- 3. Cole LA Riverside, LP sold their property to Stafford, LLC which automatically terminated their License Agreement with the conclusion of the sale.

DISCUSSION

- 4. The new agreement with Stafford, LLC covers the portion of the Canal that is shared with Tava Center for parking.
- 5. The term for the Agreement is 20 years with three 5year options to extend.
- 6. Based on the approved canal rate of \$0.66/sf, consideration will begin at \$8,786.58 with annual increases at 2%.

RECOMMENDATIONS

That the City Council:

- 1. Approve the License Agreement with Stafford, LLC for use of a portion of the Riverside Water Company Canal, also known as Assessor's Parcel Number 225-350-070, for a twenty-year term with three (3) five-year options to extend estimated total revenue of \$213,490.78; and
- 2. Authorize the City Manager, or his designee, to execute the License Agreement, including making minor and non-substantive changes, and to sign all documents necessary to complete the transaction.
