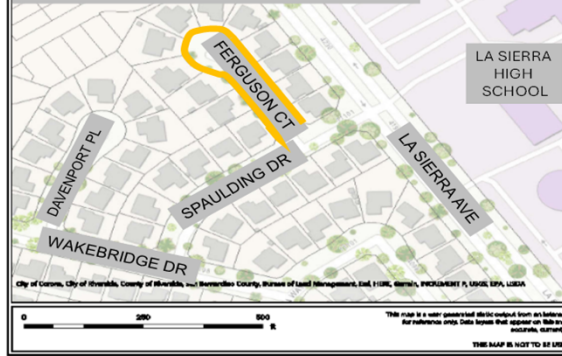

BACKGROUND

1. The Preferential Parking Program is neighborhood driven and enables eligible residential neighborhoods continually impacted by outside parking sources to pursue establishment of PPZs
2. PPZs increase availability of on-street parking for residents and their guests by requiring parked vehicles to display a PPZ permit during restricted days / times
3. PPZ permit applications cost \$64 per household for a three-year period.

DISCUSSION



1. An existing adopted and posted "1-Hour Parking between the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. except Saturday, Sunday, and holidays" PPZ is in place on Ferguson Ct. the entire street from Spaulding Dr. to the northerly terminus; and
2. Public Works received a petition from 92% (11 of 12) of residents within the Ferguson Ct. PPZ requesting removal of the PPZ.

DISCUSSION (CONTINUED)



1. Residents indicate that the existing PPZ:
 - a) Was established years ago to address overflow parking from La Sierra High School which is no longer a concern;
 - b) Inconvenience for residents and their guests;
 - c) Financially burdensome to residents; and
 - d) Restrictive to freedom and flexibility.

1. Five of eight Board members were present; and
2. The Board voted unanimously to recommend that the City Council approve removal of the existing Preferential Parking Zone on Ferguson Court.
