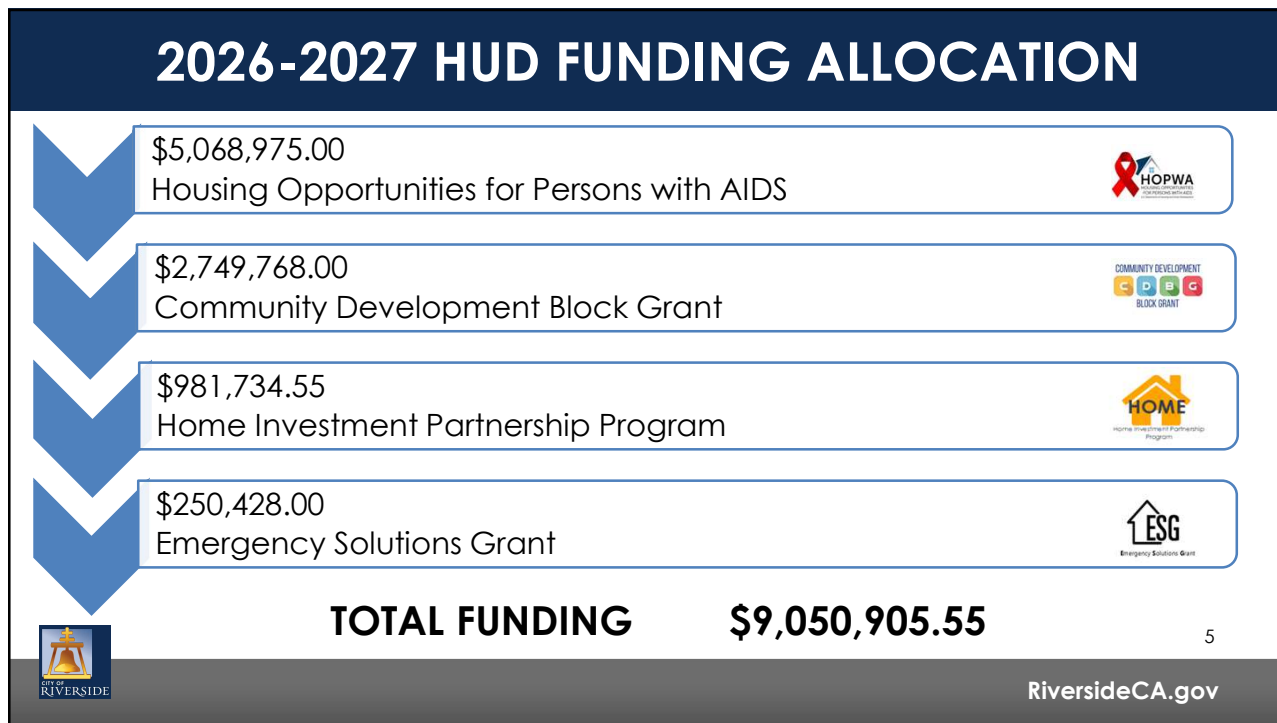

HOME INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM



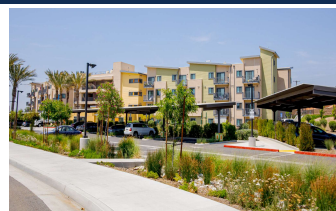
Purpose

Purpose

RECOMMENDATIONS

That the City Council:

1. Conduct the Public Hearing;
2. Adopt the 2026-2027 Annual Action Plan for expenditure of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG), Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA), and HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME) funds in the total amount of \$9,050,905.55;
3. Authorize City staff to make any necessary changes to funding recommendations for funded Community Development Block Grant, Emergency Solutions Grant, Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS, and HOME Investment Partnerships Program sub-recipients and finalize the 2026-2027 Annual Action Plan for submittal to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development;

RECOMMENDATIONS CONT.

4. Authorize the City Manager or his designee to execute the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development grant agreements for the Community Development Block Grant, Emergency Solutions Grant, Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS and HOME Investment Partnerships programs and the agreements with the City's subrecipients as identified in the 2026-2027 Annual Action Plan; and
5. With at least five affirmative votes, authorize the estimated appropriation of funds and authorize the Chief Financial Officer, or designee, to record revenue and appropriate funds among various funds and accounts established by the Finance Department for the HUD entitlement grants related to the HUD 2026-2027 Annual Action Plan.
