**YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED** that the City Council of the City of Riverside will hold a public hearing regarding the following item:

**CASE NUMBER:** Urgency Ordinance - Pallet Storage Moratorium

**APPLICANT:** City of Riverside

**LOCATION:** Citywide

**PROPOSAL:** To consider an ordinance extending the moratorium on new or expanded wooden pallet storage yards adopted pursuant to Ordinance No. 7769 for an additional 10 months and 15 days, from its current expiration of July 3, 2026, to May 18, 2027. The purpose of the proposed extension is to allow staff sufficient time to conduct outreach and develop recommendations for permanent zoning regulations for such uses.

**ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION:** The Community & Economic Development Department recommends that the City Council determine that this project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 15061(b)(3) (Common Sense) of the CEQA Guidelines, as it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility the project will have a significant effect on the environment.
