## **DISCUSSION**

- Along with Parks & Recreation Special Transportation, Public Utilities Electric Operations and Electric Field require frequent vehicle washes
- 2. The original Services Agreement was approved for one year with three (3) additional one-year terms
- 3. The original agreement was based on vendor cost and projected wash frequency
- 4. Over the initial term of the contract, it became evident that the frequency of the car washes needed to be increased.

## **RECOMMENDATIONS**

That the Board of Public Utilities recommends that the City Council:

- Approve a Second Amendment to Wash Master LLC of Beaumont, California, to increase the compensation in the amount of \$80,564.28 for a contract amount \$172,664.28
- 2. Approve a 15% change order authority in the amount of \$25,899.64, for a total contract amount \$198,563.92
- 3. Authorize the City Manager of his designee to execute the Second Amendment with Wash Master LLC, including making minor and non-substantive changes
