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ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 3.30 OF THE RIVERSIDE MUNICIPAL CODE, TO ADD ELEVEN ADDITIONAL CATEGORIES AND REVISE ONE CATEATORY TO THE SCHEDULE OF REGULATION, PRODUCTS, AND SERVICES.

The City Council of the City of Riverside does ordain as follows:

Section 1: Section 3.30.030 of the Riverside Municipal Code is amended as follows:

**“Section 3.30.030 Schedule of Regulation, Products and Services.**

A. The City Clerk, City Manager, Chief Financial Officer, and each City department head, under the direction of the City Manager, shall review annually the regulations, products and services of the City and the fees and service charges imposed by the City or recommended to be imposed by the City, and provide an adjusted fee or charge schedule to the City Council for its consideration so as to recover the percentage of costs reasonably borne as set forth in the Master Fees and Charges Schedule as necessary to provide the listed regulation, product or service:

Section 3: The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this ordinance and cause publication once in a newspaper of general circulation in accordance with Section 414 of the Charter of the City of Riverside. This ordinance shall become effective on the 30th day after the date of its adoption.
