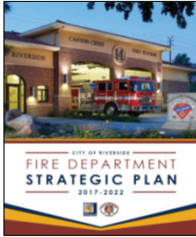

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## 2022 Housing Activity

- Entitlements approved for 515 units
- Permits issued for 585 units
  - 226 low-income deed restricted
  - 176 moderate-income deed restricted
  - 183 market rate
- Received complete applications for 457 Units
