

3. Render advice and assistance as requested to other City boards and commissions, to City departments, and to private agencies on matters affecting persons with disabilities.
4. Identify the needs of persons with disabilities and create public awareness of these needs in areas such as employment, housing, transportation, media, physical and communication accessibility, and other needed areas.
5. Promote greater awareness of the changing life patterns, opportunities, and responsibilities of persons with disabilities.
6. Promote total integration of persons with disabilities into all aspects of community life.
7. Perform other functions and duties as may be directed by the City Council.

Within this framework, the Commission on Disabilities is asked to recommend topics of interest and identify local resources for inclusion in the Commission on Disabilities Resource Guide.
