

RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE DISPLAY OF SPECIFIC COMMEMORATIVE FLAGS AT CITY FACILITIES.

WHEREAS, on January 17, 2023, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 23947 establishing the City of Riverside Flag Policy ("Flag Policy"), attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the Flag Policy set forth guidelines to ensure the uniform handling and display of flags at City facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Flag Policy also set forth guidelines for the display of commemorate flags; and

WHEREAS, under the Flag Policy, a commemorative flag means a flag that identifies with a specific date, historical event, cause, or group of people, whereby the City honors or commemorates the date, event, cause, or people by flying the flag; and

WHEREAS, commemorative flags may be displayed only as authorized by resolution of the City Council and as an expression of the City's official sentiments; and

WHEREAS, on June 6, 2023, the City Council adopted Resolution number 23996, approving a schedule for display of established or commonly recognized commemorative flags for 2023; and

WHEREAS, per the Flag Policy, commemorative flags may be displayed at City Hall and, where possible, at other City facilities upon City Council action, consistent with the City's vision, mission, and strategic plan; and

WHEREAS, on January 16, 2024, the City Council reviewed and approved the commemorative flags schedule for the upcoming year and directed staff to return to a subsequent City Council meeting with a resolution supporting the City's display of the flags chosen.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, as follows:

Section 1. The above recitals set forth above are incorporated herein as findings by the City Council.

Section 2. Per the Flag Policy adopted via Resolution No. 23947, attached hereto as Exhibit “A” and incorporated herein by reference, commemorative flags may be displayed at City Hall and, where possible, at other City facilities, and shall be consistent with the City’s vision, mission, and strategic plan.

Section 3. Per the Flag Policy, the City Council hereby authorizes the display of commemorative flags at City Hall and, where possible, at other City facilities, as follows:

1. Holocaust Remembrance Day (January 27 only)
2. Black History Month (February, entire month)
3. Women's Suffrage Victory Flag (March, entire month)
4. LGBTQ Pride Month (June, entire month except for June 19)
5. Juneteenth (June 19 only)
