A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION, AND ACCEPTANCE OF, GRANT FUNDS FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA - CALIFORNIA ARTS COUNCIL, FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION BY THE RIVERSIDE ARTS ACADEMY TO SUPPORT ARTS EDUCATION, MUSICAL INSTRUMENTS, EQUIPMENT AND FACILITIES PROJECTS.

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of California, in cooperation with the California State Legislature, has approved a grant for a project to be administered by the Riverside Arts Academy to fund Arts Education, Musical Instruments, Equipment and Facilities; and

WHEREAS, the California Arts Council has been delegated the responsibility for the administration of the grant project, setting up necessary procedures governing application by local agencies, non-profit organizations, and others under the program; and

WHEREAS, said procedures established by the California Arts Council require the applicant to certify by resolution the approval of application before submission of said application to the State; and

WHEREAS, the applicant will enter into a Grant Agreement with the State of California for the grant project to fund Arts Education, Musical Instruments, Equipment and Facilities administered through the Riverside Arts Academy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, as follows:

Section 1: Approves the filing of an application for grant funds with the State of California, California Arts Council, for the grant project to fund Arts Education, Musical Instruments, Equipment and Facilities administered through the Riverside Arts Academy in an amount not to exceed Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00).

Section 2: Agrees to, and if awarded, does accept the grant funds in an amount not to exceed Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00).

<u>Section 3</u>: Certifies that the City has or will have sufficient funds to operate and maintain the project or will enter into an agreement with Riverside Arts Academy to perform said project.
