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RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE RECEIPT OF FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF TWENTY-FIVE MILLION DOLLARS (\$25,000,000) FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA AS PROVIDED FOR IN ITS BUDGET ACT OF 2022, AS ENACTED BY ASSEMBLY BILL 1624 AND SENATE BILL 840 AND AMENDED BY ASSEMBLY BILL 178, FOR THE SUBSTANTIAL RENOVATION OF THE CESAR CHAVEZ COMMUNITY CENTER AND RELATED BUILDINGS LOCATED AT 2060 UNIVERSITY AVENUE, AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF ALL REQUIRED DOCUMENTS BY THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE.

WHEREAS, the State of California (“State”) funds a large variety of local projects through its annual budgeting process that assists localities to complete vital projects that positively impact the health and safety of state residents; and

WHEREAS, State of California in its Budget Act of 2022 (“Budget Act”), as enacted by Assembly Bill 1624 and Senate Bill 840 and amended by Assembly Bill 178, allocated Twenty-Five Million Dollars (\$25,000,000) to the City of Riverside (“City”) for the substantial renovation of the Cesar Chavez Community Center and associated buildings at Bobby Bonds Park (“Grant”); and

WHEREAS, the California Natural Resources Agency has been delegated responsibility for administration of the Grant project by the State, setting up necessary procedures; and

WHEREAS, said procedures established by the California Natural Resources Agency require the City to certify by Resolution the approval of a Project Information Package before submission of said package to the State; and

WHEREAS, the State Appropriation mandates that the City, a public entity, act as the local recipient and administrator of funds; and

WHEREAS, the City proposes to substantially renovate the Cesar Chavez Community Center, completing necessary structural, mechanical, and other modernization of its main building and its associated structures; and

WHEREAS, the City is familiar with the terms, conditions and limitations of the Grant; and

WHEREAS, the City is willing to administer and monitor funds as mandated by the State; and

1           WHEREAS, the Appropriation will require the City to execute a Grant Agreement with the  
2 State and other necessary documents for completion of the project upon approval.

3           NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside,  
4 California, as follows:

5           Section 1: The City certifies that it will have sufficient funds to develop, operate and  
6 maintain the project consistent with the land tenure requirements of a Grant Agreement with the  
7 State; or will secure the resources to do so.

8           Section 2: The City certifies that it will comply with the provisions of Section 1771.5 of the  
9 California Labor Code.

10          Section 3: If applicable, the City certifies that the project will comply with any laws and  
11 regulation including, but not limited to, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), legal  
12 requirements for building codes, health and safety codes, disabled access laws, environmental laws  
13 and, that prior to commencement of construction, all applicable licenses and permits will have been  
14 obtained.

15          Section 4: The City certifies that said agency has reviewed and understands the General  
16 Provisions contained in the sample Grant Agreement contained in the State’s “Procedural Guide for  
17 General Fund Specified Development and Acquisition Grant Projects.”

18          Section 5: That the City Manager or designee is hereby authorized to conduct all negotiations,  
19 execute a Grant Agreement with the State for Appropriation funding, and any and all other necessary  
20 documents for the purpose of obtaining and administering the Grant and completion of the project,  
21 including any extensions and amendments thereof.

22          Section 6: The City of Riverside hereby agrees to comply with each and all of the terms,  
23 conditions, and limitations imposed by the Grant, and the City Manager or designee is hereby  
24 authorized and directed to execute any and all agreements, assurance, payment requests, or other  
25 documents as may be necessary in connection with acceptance and implementation of said Grant as  
26 may be required by the State.
