RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE **ESTABLISHMENT** OF **COMMUNITY** DEVELOPMENT ENTITY AND SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO **FEDERAL NEW MARKETS** TAX **CREDITS PROGRAM** ADMINISTERED BY THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF THE TREASURY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS FUND AND **AUTHORIZING** THE EXECUTION ALL **REOUIRED** OF DOCUMENTS BY THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE.

WHEREAS, the Department of the Treasury New Markets Tax Credit Program (NMTC Program), established in 2000, helps economically distressed communities attract private capital by providing investors with a federal tax credit. Investments made through the NMTC Program are used to finance businesses which invest into neglected and underserved low-income communities. The program has recently been made permanent by the U.S. Congress; and

WHEREAS, annually, the U.S. Department of the Treasury Community Development Financial Institutions Fund ("Grantor"), has heretofore invited eligible entities, including the City of Riverside ("City"), to submit applications to the NMTC Program (the "Tax Credits") via a Notice of Funding Availability issued in approximately fall of each year; and

WHEREAS, in response to the annual Notice of Availability, the City of Riverside, a California charter city and municipal corporation, wishes to apply for Tax Credits; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that it is in its best interests to submit an application for Tax Credits in a regional approach that would attract capital to fund residential and economic development projects that would be available to the City as well as provide eligible investment opportunities to areas of greater Riverside, San Bernardino, Imperial, Kern, Tulare, Kings, and Inyo Counties; and

WHEREAS, the City must establish itself as a Treasury certified Community Development Entity (CDE) in order to receive, syndicate, and use the sale of Tax Credit proceeds to fund projects. Pursuant to the NMTC Program, the City would also form a Community Development Entity which would establish an Executive Committee and an Advisory Committee to guide NMTC activities; and
