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RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING THE CITY'S MASTER FEES AND CHARGES SCHEDULE AS SET FORTH IN RESOLUTION NO. 21960, AS AMENDED, PROVIDING FOR ADJUSTMENTS FOR VARIOUS DEVELOPMENT SERVICES DEPARTMENTS AND OTHER USER FEES AND CHARGES AND PARKING BAIL SCHEDULE, AND AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE MASTER FEES AND CHARGES SCHEDULE.

WHEREAS, the City has the authority to impose fees pursuant to its authority under Article XI, §7 of the California Constitution and under its complementary powers under Section 37112 of the California Government Code and Section 200 of the Riverside City Charter; and

WHEREAS, the City has established a policy of recovering the full costs reasonably borne as a result of providing special services of a voluntary and limited nature, such that general taxes are not diverted from general services of a broad nature and thereby utilized to subsidize unfairly and inequitably such special services; and

WHEREAS, in Chapter 3.30 of the Riverside Municipal Code, the City Council established its policy as to the recovery of costs and more particularly the percentage of costs reasonably borne to be recovered from users of City services and directing staff as to the methodology for implementing said Chapter 3.30; and

WHEREAS, the adoption of a schedule of fees and charges to be paid by those requesting such special services and the percentage of costs reasonably borne by those persons receiving such special services are necessary so that the City might effectuate its policies; and

WHEREAS, the adjusted fees will allow the City to recover the reasonable costs incurred by the City in providing services; and

WHEREAS, the specific fees to be charged for services are to be reviewed annually and be adopted by resolution of the City Council after providing notice and holding a public hearing as required by law; and

WHEREAS, on June 20, 2023, the City amended Resolution No. 21960, its Master Fees and Charges Resolution, thereby approving and authorizing the Finance Director to maintain the City's

1 Master Fees and Charges Schedule and to amend the Master Fees and Charges Schedule consistent
2 with authorization from City Council; and

3 WHEREAS, on June 25, 2024, the City adopted the FY 2024/2025 Master Fees and Charges
4 schedule which included a comprehensive update to most citywide fees and charged based on the
5 finding of the study performed by MGT of America Consulting, LLC (“MGT”); and

6 WHEREAS, that schedule did not include updated fees and charges for departments that
7 provide certain development services (Public Works and Community & Economic Development) as
8 more time was needed to finalize the fee study in these areas; and

9 WHEREAS, during MGT’s continued study of the City’s development services departments
10 for FY 2024/2025, certain new cost recovery fees were identified for inclusion in the City’s Master
11 Fees and Charges Schedule and certain existing fees have been adjusted as described in Exhibit “A”,
12 attached hereto and incorporated herein; and

13 WHEREAS, City staff also recommend increasing all violations in the Parking Bail Schedule
14 as shown in the Master Fees and Charges Schedule; and

15 WHEREAS, the City Council held a duly noticed public hearing on April 15, 2025, and
16 considered all oral and written evidence presented regarding the revisions to the Master Fees and
17 Charges Schedule; and

18 WHEREAS, all requirements of law regarding the notice and the provision of data are hereby
19 found to have been met; and

20 WHEREAS, the City desires to amend the Master Fees and Charges Schedule, Resolution No.
21 21960 and its related amendments.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED based upon the foregoing facts, the staff report, the
23 cost analyses and other evidence submitted to the City Council at the March 11, 2025 and April 15,
24 2025 City Council meetings, by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, as follows:

25 Section 1: The above recitals are hereby found to be true and correct and are hereby
26 incorporated herein as if stated in full.

1 Section 2: The City Council hereby determines that the specific fees to be charged for
2 services, which are set forth in Exhibit “A,” Schedule of Fees and Charges, attached hereto and
3 incorporated herein by reference, are the reasonable costs for service and hereby adopts the same.

4 Section 3: Resolution No. 21960 and all applicable amendments thereto are hereby
5 amended to include the new fees as shown in Exhibit “A” herein.

6 Section 4: This Resolution, together with any other resolution amending Resolution No.
7 21960 and the accompanying Master Fees and Charges Schedule, shall collectively be known as, and
8 hereinafter may be interchangeably referred to as, the “Fees and Charges Resolution,” “Schedule of
9 Fees and Charges,” or the “Master Fees and Charges Schedule.”

10 Section 5: All fees set by this Resolution are for each identified process or service; additional
11 fees shall be required for each additional process or service that is requested or required.

12 Section 6: The fees and charges revisions set forth in Exhibit “A” fall within the stated
13 exceptions to the definition of “tax” established by Proposition 26, and therefore, are not subject to
14 the requirements of Article XIII C of the California Constitution.

15 Section 7: The Finance Director is hereby directed and authorized to maintain a current
16 Master Fees and Charges Schedule which will include all amendments to the Fees and Charges
17 Resolution.

18 Section 8: If any portion of this Resolution is for any reason declared invalid or
19 unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect
20 the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution; the City Council hereby declaring that it
21 would have adopted this Resolution and every other section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph,
22 item, sub-item, clause, phrase, or portion thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more section,
23 subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, item, sub-item, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion be declared
24 invalid or unconstitutional.

25 Section 9: The provisions of this resolution pertaining to the following fees shall become
26 effective thirty (30) days from date of approval by City Council:

27 4184 Supplemental Residential Waste Services

28 4185 Supplemental Commercial Waste Services

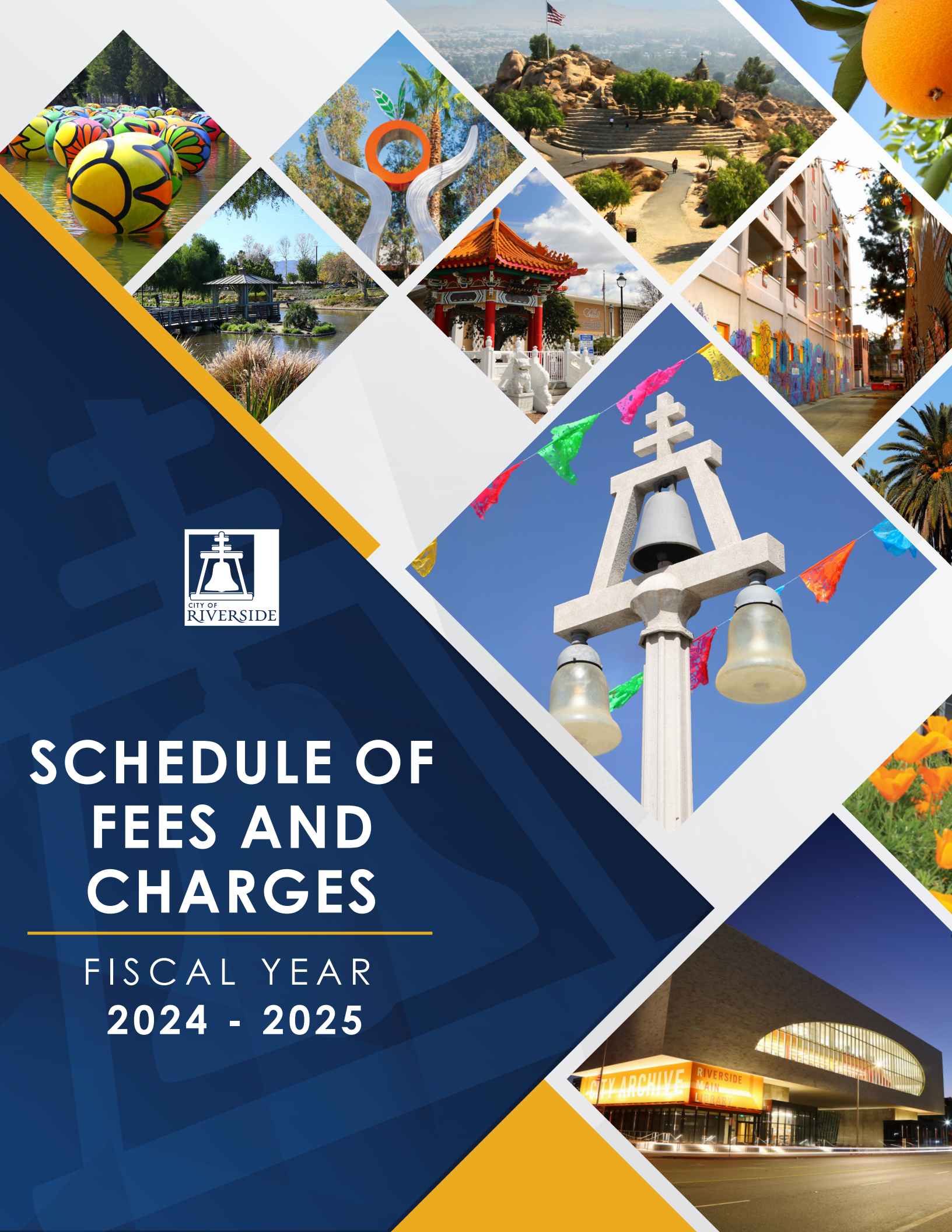
