



Path of Life

The Path of Life is a 24 HR. 60 Day Emergency Shelter Program in Riverside, CA that takes in unsheltered adults & families.

Mercy House Hulen

Mercy House is a transitional shelter that accepts unsheltered adults that have a housing plan in place.

Helping Hearts

Helping Hearts is a Recuperative shelter ran by IEHP that accepts unsheltered adults suffering from mild to moderate mental health issues. Adults must have IEHP as their insurer.

Illumination Foundation

Illumination Foundation is a Recuperative Care Shelter that accepts adults who have recently been discharged from a hospital that need shelter to recover from their medical condition(s).
