BID DESCRIPTION: The project involves street maintenance and improvement work at various locations throughout the City of Riverside. In general, the scope includes cold milling of deteriorated asphalt pavement, application of ARAM and CSPB, and resurfacing with dense-graded asphalt concrete (DGAC). Additional work includes slurry sealing of streets, repairing damaged concrete sidewalks, driveways, pedestrian ramps, curbs and gutters, and cross gutters. The project also includes replacement of traffic striping, installation of new signage, and excavation of existing alleyways. Asphalt millings generated from other project locations will be transported and reused within this project.
