

MEASURE Z – BID 7995 FY 2022/23 ARTERIAL AND MINOR STREET MAINTENANCE, PHASE 3

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BACKGROUND

- The Public Works Department utilizes a Pavement Management Program and receives service requests from residents to plan various maintenance improvements throughout the City.
- 2. Every fiscal year, the Public Works Department budgets a portion of State Gas Tax, County Measure A, and City Measure Z revenues for street rehabilitation of City arterial and minor streets. This project will primarily focus on rehabilitation of streets in poor condition.



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BACKGROUND

- 3. On December 6, 2022, the City Council received a list of proposed maintenance locations to be completed with the various Fiscal Year 2022/23 funding sources.
- 4. The maintenance improvements included in Bid 7995 were locations included in the complete list provided in the report from December 2022.
- 5. The Book of Work sets a target of over 50 miles of paving treatments in Calendar Year 2024.



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CURRENT PROJECT

- 1. Resurface 0.4 miles on one collector street:
 - Tyler Street from Arlington Avenue to Verona Street.
- 2. Resurface 5.8 miles of local streets within five different neighborhoods.
- 3. Remove the existing splash pad in the Main Street Mall between University Avenue and Mission Inn Boulevard.



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CURRENT PROJECT

- 4. Reconstruct damaged concrete curbs, gutters, sidewalks, driveways, and non-compliant pedestrian ramps within all rehabilitation locations.
- 5. Install new signing and striping throughout as necessary.
- 6. Install new traffic signals at the following intersections:
 - Wells Avenue and Challen Avenue
 - Main Street and Placentia Lane
 - Lincoln Avenue and Monroe Street

- Award Bid No. 7995 for Fiscal Year 2022/23 Arterial and Minor Streets Maintenance, Phase 3 to All American Asphalt, of Corona, California, in the amount of \$6,809,118; and
- 2. Authorize the City Manager, or designee, to execute the construction contract with All American Asphalt, including making minor non-substantial changes, subject to the availability of budgeted funds.



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
