


MAIN STREET – ESTABLISHMENT OF TIMED 30-MINUTE PARKING ZONE

BACKGROUND

- 1.The City works with local businesses to establish no parking loading zones to provide safe curbside freight distribution of goods & materials;
- 2. Time limited no parking loading zones help to maximize usage of on-street parking curb space during non-restricted times; and
- 3. Eliminate moving vans and delivery trucks from parking adjacent to designated fire lanes, blocking two-way alley access and blocking parking stalls in the shared alley.

DISCUSSION

- Due to inadequate loading zone availability, delivery trucks and moving trucks often park for several hours next to designated fire lanes, making the alley parking spaces inaccessible, & blocking the circulation of the shared alley; and
- Extending the no parking loading zone by 40 feet (70 feet total) would provide immediate delivery and moving truck access to the adjacent properties and facilitate the safe and efficient movement along the shared alley.

RECOMMENDATION

That the Transportation Board recommend that the City Council approve the extension of a "No Parking Loading Zone 6:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m." on the south side of Sixth Street from 220 feet east of Market Street to 40 feet easterly thereof
