SUBJECT: PRESENTATION FROM PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT TRAFFIC ENGINEERING

ISSUE:

Receive a presentation from Public Works Traffic Engineering on transportation and traffic-related topics that may affect members of the Deaf community.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Commission of a Deaf receive and file an informational presentation from Public Works Traffic Engineering on transportation grants, plans, and intersection-level traffic safety improvements that may affect members of the Deaf community.

LEGISLATIVE HISTORY:

On January 24, 2023, the City Council approved the recommendation to introduce an ordinance establishing a Commission of the Deaf, and the first reading of the ordinance adding Chapter 2.100, Commission of the Deaf, to the City's Municipal Code, was held. The final ordinance was adopted on February 7, 2023.

Receiving this presentation is in compliance with Ordinance No. 7623, Section 2.100.040 "Powers, Duties and Functions" which states in part:

- C. Render advise and assistance as requested to other City boards and commissions, and to City departments on matters affecting members of the deaf community.

DISCUSSION:

Public Works Traffic Engineering will present to the Commission on transportation grants, plans, and intersection-level traffic safety improvements that may affect members of the Deaf community.
