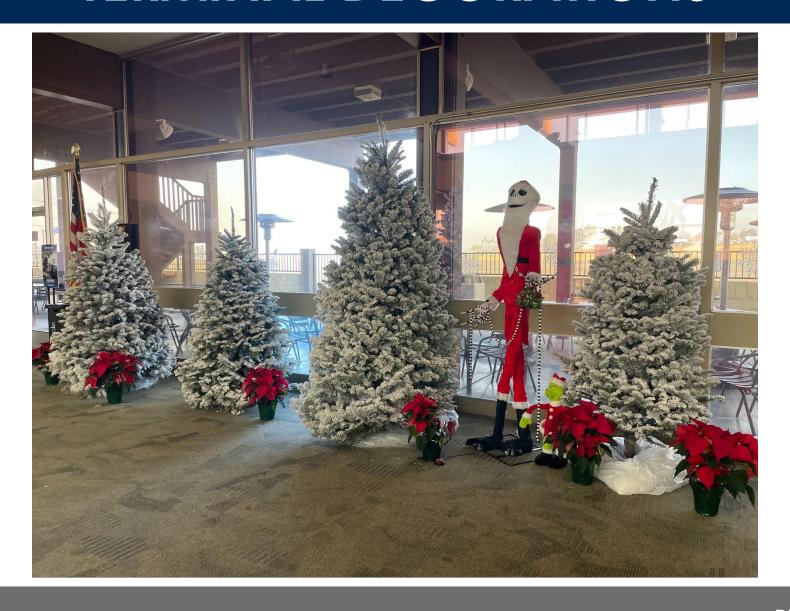

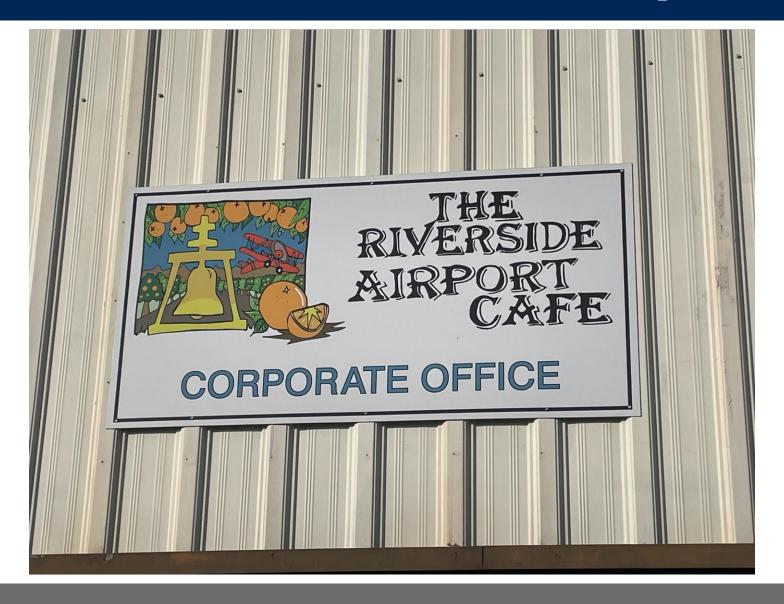

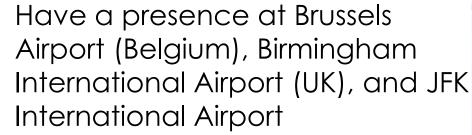




CLEAN TECH / ECON DEVELOPMENT
