

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DISCUSSION

- Public Works' review determined that the cul-de-sac:
 - 1.Provides no access to the Riviera Communities housing tract or adjacent businesses; and
 - 2.Though there is a catch basin at the end of the cul-de-sac no utilities run along the cul-de-sac.



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DISCUSSION (CONTINUED) To mitigate ongoing issues Public Works is proposing a 12-month cul-de-sac closure pilot project on the west leg of Alamo St. at Rivera St. / Apple Grove; A swing gate and signage to close the cul-de-sac is proposed; and The swing gate will continue to allow cul-de-sac access for emergency and service vehicles.



PILOT PROJECT BENEFITS

- The 12-month pilot project is anticipated to reduce or eliminate illegal dumping and parking within the culde-sac and to deter graffiti, loitering activity, trash and debris;
- The swing gate will continue to allow cul-de-sac access for emergency and service vehicles; and
- The pilot project allows review of effectiveness/impacts prior to considering permanent improvements.
- Transportation Board recommended approval (5/24)
