

1 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA,  
2 AMENDING TITLE 7 OF THE RIVERSIDE MUNICIPAL CODE BY  
3 ADDING SECTION 7.10.091 REGARDING A DEFINITION FOR “LIVE  
PERFORMANCE”

4 The City Council of the City of Riverside does ordain as follows:

5 Section 1: The Table of Contents for Chapter 7.10 of the Riverside Municipal Code  
6 entitled “Definitions” is hereby amended to read as follows:

7 **“Chapter 7.10 – Definitions**

9 **7.10.010 Definitions generally.**

11 **7.10.090 Intrusive noise.**

15 **7.10.210 Supplementary definitions of technical terms.**

16 Section 2: Section 7.10.091 is a proposed addition to the Riverside Municipal Code and  
17 is hereby written as follows:

18 **“Section 7.10.091 Live performance.**

19 “Live performance” means any presentation or act designed to amuse or divert the attention of  
20 guests, patrons, attendees, or any present individuals. It includes, but is not limited to, presentations  
21 or acts by bands, musicians, singers, and individuals operating sound amplifying equipment as part  
22 of a performance.

23 Section 3. The City Council has reviewed the matter and, by based upon the facts and  
24 information contained in the staff reports, administrative record, and written and oral testimony,  
25 hereby finds that this ordinance is not subject to CEQA pursuant to Sections 15060(c)(2),  
26 15060(c)(3) and/or 15061(b)(3) of the State CEQA Guidelines, California Code of Regulations,  
27 Title 14, Chapter 3, in that it will not result in a direct or reasonably foreseeable indirect physical  
28 change.
