

**SECOND AMENDMENT
TO AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT SUBRECIPIENT AGREEMENT**

REBECCA ACEVEDO dba A SQUARED CONSULTING

PROJECT BRIDGE PROGRAM

THIS SECOND AMENDMENT TO AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT SUBRECIPIENT AGREEMENT (“Second Amendment”) is made and entered into this 13th day of June, 2024, by and between THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, a California charter city and municipal corporation (“City”), and REBECCA ACEVEDO, a sole proprietor doing business as A SQUARED CONSULTING (“Subrecipient”), with respect to the following:

RECITALS

WHEREAS, on or about September 15, 2022, the City and Subrecipient entered into that certain American Rescue Plan Act Subrecipient Agreement (“Agreement”) for Project Bridge Program funding; and

WHEREAS, on or about September 14, 2023, the City and Subrecipient entered into that certain First Amendment to American Rescue Plan Act Subrecipient Agreement to add the requirement that instructors’ names be processed through the Megan’s Law database; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement is set to expire December 31, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the City and Subrecipient desire to extend the expiration date of the Agreement for one (1) additional year, to December 31, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the City and Subrecipient desire to amend the Agreement to increase grant allocation in the amount of Eighty-Eight Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$88,500.00) for three (3) additional NYOCP Cohorts, for a total contract amount not to exceed Four Hundred Forty-Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$442,500.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing recitals which are incorporated herein by this reference, City and Subrecipient agree as follows:

1. Section 2, Term, is hereby amended to extend the expiration date of the Agreement for one (1) additional year, to December 31, 2025.

2. Section 3, Grant Funds, is hereby amended to include additional grant allocation in the amount of Eighty-Eight Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$88,500.00) for three (3) additional NYOCP Cohorts, for a total contract amount not to exceed Four Hundred Forty-Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$442,500.00).

3. All other terms and conditions of the Agreement between the parties, which are not inconsistent with the terms of this Second Amendment, shall remain in full force and effect as if fully set forth herein.
