SUBJECT: DISCUSSION REGARDING THE DEVELOPMENT OF A COMMUNITY SURVEY TO ASSESS ACCESSIBILITY AND SERVICES FOR INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES.

ISSUE:

Discussion regarding the development of a community survey to assess accessibility and services for individuals with disabilities.

RECOMMENDATION:

Discuss the proposed development of a community survey designed to gather feedback regarding accessibility, programs, services, and barriers experienced by individuals with disabilities. Provide staff with information regarding the survey content, distribution methods, and outreach strategies.

BACKGROUND:

The Commission is committed to promoting accessibility, inclusion, and equal opportunities for individuals with disabilities within the community. To better understand the needs and experiences of residents, staff proposes developing a community survey that will collect feedback on City facilities, programs, services, communication, transportation, and other accessibility-related issues.

The survey will provide valuable information to help identify areas where improvements may be needed and assist the Commission in making informed recommendations to the City Council.

DISCUSSION:

The proposed survey will seek input from residents with disabilities, family members, caregivers, advocates, and the community.

Following Commission feedback, staff will finalize the survey and return with the completed version if further review is requested prior to public distribution.
