A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, TO SUPPORT THE CREATION OF AN AMENDMENT TO THE 2014 MARCH AIR RESERVE BASE/INLAND PORT AIRPORT LAND USE COMPATIBILITY PLAN (MARCH ARB/INLAND PORT ALUCP) TO ASSURE COMPATIBLE LAND USES NEAR MARCH AIR RESERVE BASE TO PROTECT THE FUTURE AVIATION OPERATIONS OF THE UNITED STATES MILITARY

WHEREAS, the economic benefit from the continuing operation of March Air Reserve Base is a vital component of the regional economy estimated to be approximately \$579 Million Dollars annually, and thus protection of its operational capacity is vital to the local and regional economy; and

WHEREAS, there is a demonstrated need for the Cities of Riverside, Moreno Valley, Perris and the County of Riverside and the March Joint Powers Authority to work cooperatively to protect the public health, safety, and welfare through participation in Amending the 2014 March Air Reserve Base/Inland Port Airport Land Use Compatibility Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>: The City Council hereby pleadges support and participation in the process of Amending the 2014 March Air Reserve Base/ Inland Port Airport Land Use Compatibility Plan.

<u>Section 2</u>: The City Council recognizes that the Riverside County Airport Land Use Commission (RCALUC) is the appropriate sponsor for the amendment.

Section 3: The City Council commits to provide in-kind technical support and/or financial support for the preparation of the Amendment and appropriate environmental documentation. The budget for the Amendment and the appropriate Environmental documentation is estimated at One Hundred and Twenty-Five Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$125,000.00) which will be shared equally by each of the above referenced Jurisdictions and the March Joint Powers Authority or its successor agency. The commitment of financial support shall not exceed Twenty-Five Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$25,000.00) from each Jurisdiction or agency.

Section 4: The City Council commits to use its best efforts to implement appropriate recommendations identified in the Amended March ARB/Inland Port ALUCP to assure that only

1	compatible development will occur in the Clear Zones, Accident Potential Zones, and the areas within
2	the March Air Reserve Base/Inland Port Airport Land Use Compatibility Plan to protect the future
3	aviation operations of the United State Military.
