#### BACKGROUND:

The Airport Manager's Operation and Activity Report is provided to inform the Airport Commission (Commission) about operations, City Council actions, events, meetings and other issues concerning the Riverside Municipal Airport (Airport).

Aircraft activity continues to increase at Riverside Municipal Airport. Month over month, we experienced a 10.1% increase in the number of takeoffs and landings. It is anticipated that numbers will continue to increase, especially this Fall, as students at CBU, for instance, return to class and the skies.

For the first month of the current fiscal year, expenditures and revenues were mostly on target with the budget. The airport continues to explore areas in which to increase airport revenues (such as issuing the Westside RFP and increasing fuel flow fees), while also effectively limiting expenditures (such as performing tree trimming and some concrete work in-house).

## Events

*Quarterly tenant meeting.* Third-quarter meeting held July 27, 2023. It was well-attended, and the City of Riverside Public Safety Engagement Team provided an informative presentation. The next quarterly tenant meeting is scheduled for October 12, 2023, in the Airport Terminal.
