ISSUE:

Recommend excusing the absence of Board Member Crohn from the Board of Public Utilities meeting on September 25, 2023.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

That the Board of Public Utilities excuse the absence of Board Member Crohn from the Board of Public Utilities meeting held September 25, 2023.

BACKGROUND:

Pursuant to the Board/Commission Attendance Policy in Resolution No. 23976, Board Members shall make every effort to notify the administrative staff 24 hours prior to any regular meeting of his-her intent not to attend said meeting. The Board is required to express in its official minutes if the absence of the Board Member is excused or unexcused.

Pursuant to City Charter Section 805, if a member of a Board or Commission is absent from three consecutive regular meetings unless by permission of the Board or Commission expressed in its official minutes, the City Council can declare the office vacant.

DISCUSSION:

Staff received advanced notification that Board Member Crohn would not attend the September 25, 2023, Board of Public Utilities meeting.
