RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDS FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA ENERGY COMMISSION FOR THE CALIFORNIA AUTOMATED PERMIT PROCESSING PROGRAM TO COMPLY WITH SENATE BILL 379 AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF NECESSARY GRANT DOCUMENTS BY THE CITY MANAGER, OR HIS DESIGNEE.

WHEREAS, to meet its clean energy goals, California needs to facilitate new, renewable clean energy resources, including rooftop solar and storage systems; and

WHEREAS, achieving 100% clean energy in California requires an acceleration of the development of rooftop solar projects; and

WHEREAS, on September 16, 2022, Senate Bill 379 ("SB 379") was approved by Governor Newsom which required most California cities and counties to implement an online, automated permitting platform that verifies code compliance instantly and issues permits in real time for solar energy systems; and

WHEREAS, in April of 2023, the City of Riverside ("City") was awarded a grant not to exceed One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) and available for liquidation until June 30, 2027, by the State of California Energy Commission ("Grantor") as part of the California Automated Permit Process Program ("CalAPP") to aid in complying with SB 379; and

WHEREAS, the CalAPP funding is intended to encourage cities and counties to further enhance permitting processes and accelerate turnarounds times, particularly regarding plan review; and

WHEREAS, the CalAPP funding is intended to promote the development of residential solar and solar-plus-storage systems, greatly decreasing approval times, cutting permitting costs for local governments and homeowners, and helping California meet its greenhouse gas emission reduction goals through an easier installation process; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that the CalAPP grant funds will be used to further enhance the City's permit tracking software interface with the Solar APP+ system to help ensure a seamless process that captures all needed data in a timely manner while expediting solar projects; and
