BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this designation includes woodwork, doors/ transoms, and bulletin boards on interior hallways, in addition to the exterior of the structure.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this designation includes the landscaping plan on the north and west sides of the designated building.
