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GRANT BACKGROUND





Regional Early Action Planning Grants of 2021 (REAP 2.0)

 Awarded SCAG \$231.5 million to support local agencies with 6th cycle Housing Element implementation


Housing Infill on Public and Private Lands (HIPP) Pilot Program

- SCAG released call for applications in May 2023
- \$8,000,000 for projects which focus on
 - 1. Corridor wide infill housing initiatives; or
 - 2. Scale up development of surplus land with affordable housing

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MISSING MIDDLE HOUSING

What is missing middle housing?

 Refers to the lack of diverse medium-density housing types (i.e., duplexes, triplexes, live-work units etc.) in between detached single family residences and high-density apartment complexes



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PROJECT OVERVIEW


- City staff & Consultant will develop preapproved prototype plans for a variety of smaller scale multifamily housing types designed for existing infill sites
- Will streamline infill development by providing technical construction plans for a variety of housing typologies



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RECOMMENDATIONS

Staff recommends that the City Council:

- 1. Approve a Professional Consultant Services Agreement with RADAR Inc. of Los Angeles, CA for Request for Proposal (RFP) No. 2439, for the Missing Middle Prototype Plans for Infill Housing Sites Project, for a one-year term with an optional one-year extension not to exceed a total compensation amount of \$500,000; and
- **2. Authorize** the City Manager, or his designee, to execute the Professional Consultant Services Agreement and subsequent related agreement(s), as necessary, with RADAR Inc, including making minor and non-substantive changes including but not limited to exercising the option to extend.



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
