1. June 27, 2023: City Council requested staff investigate a financial assistance program for solid waste customers
2. The program would coincide with a proposed five-year rate plan, for which a public hearing is scheduled for September 19, 2023

DISCUSSION

1. The proposed SHARE credit for solid waste was developed in proportion to existing credits offered for the RPU Water SHARE program.
2. The proposed program would start with a monthly credit of \$1.94 and increase to \$7.12 by the close of the proposed five-year rate plan.

DISCUSSION

1. A Solid Waste SHARE program could not be funded through rates.
 1. Non-Rate Revenue – Recycling Fees, Curbside Material & Street Sweeping Fines
 2. General Fund subsidy
 3. American Rescue Plan Act (temporary)
2. The program is anticipated to serve 3,679 residential customers and would be available Citywide
3. The total cost of the five-year program would be \$1,104,425.00
