A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION FOR, AND ACCEPTANCE OF, ANY FUNDS FROM THE UNITED STATES ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY'S ENVIRONMENTAL AND CLIMATE JUSTICE **COMMUNITY CHANGE GRANTS PROGRAM** AND AUTHORIZING THE **EXECUTION** OF ALL NECESSARY GRANT DOCUMENTS BY THE CITY MANAGER, OR HIS DESIGNEE.

WHEREAS, the United States Environmental Protection Agency (the "Grantor"), has invited public and not-for-profit agencies, including the City of Riverside ("City"), to submit applications to the Grantor for the Environmental and Climate Justice Community Change Grants Program ("Grant Program") via a notice of funding availability released on November 21, 2023; and

WHEREAS, in response to this notice of funding availability, the City, a public entity, wishes to apply to the Grantor for, and receive an allocation of, grant funds; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that it is in its best interests to submit an application for grant funds for pollution reduction, climate resilience, and capacity building projects and programs in-and-around the City's greater Casa Blanca Neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, the City shall submit an application to the Grantor to participate in the Grant Program and for an allocation of funds not to exceed Twenty Million Dollars (\$20,000,000) for projects that reduce pollution, increase community climate resilience, and build community capacity in-and-around the City's greater Casa Blanca Neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, the City is familiar with the terms, conditions and limitations of any such Grant; and

WHEREAS, the City is willing and able to conform to each of the terms, conditions, and limitations imposed upon any such grant to the City; and

WHEREAS, the Grantor must approve said application and will require the City to execute a Funding Agreement and other necessary documents upon approval.
