
SBVC Aeronautics is working toward a flight school partnership to offer Private Pilot through Commercial Pilot training.



FAA -AT-CTI Air Traffic-Collegiate Training Initiative


Graduates of the Flight Ops -ATC degree or Flight Ops with ATC classes are eligible for FAA training in OK and already met the required Basic Training Coursework


