BACKGROUND

Springs Power Plant



- Commissioned in 2002
- 22 years in operation

Clearwater Power Plant



- 28 MW
- Commissioned in 2005
- 19 years in operation
- Forecasted retirement \rightarrow 2030 Forecasted retirement \rightarrow 2040 •

Riverside Energy Resource Center (RERC)



- 196 MW
- Units 1 & 2 Commissioned in 2006
- 18 years in operation
- Units 3 & 4 Commissioned in 2011
- 13 years in operation
- Forecasted retirement → 2040

BACKGROUND

- 1. At the Board meeting held on January 13, 2025, staff gave a presentation on ten proposed 2025 Generation projects that will require Board approval.
- 2. Three of these projects have already been approved by the Board. However, six other projects are experiencing delays in their RFP releases or contract negotiations.
- 3. These delays will in turn impact their anticipated Board approval timelines.
