RIVERSIDE ENERGY RESOURCE CENTER UNIT 3 GAS TURBINE REPAIRS UPDATE

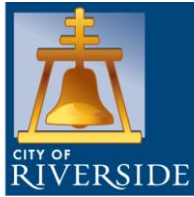
The Board of Public Utilities received and ordered filed an update of the gas turbine repairs on Unit 3 at Riverside Energy Resource Center.

Senior Deputy City Attorney Anthony Beaumon announced there were no reportable actions taken during the closed session.

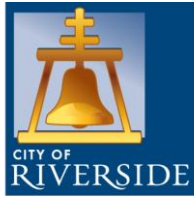
DISCUSSION CALENDAR

INTER-UTILITY SERVICE AGREEMENT - MOBILE-HOME AND MULTI-FAMILY ENERGY EFFICIENCY PROGRAM

Following discussion, it was moved by Board Member Evans and seconded by Board Member Wright to recommend that the City Council (1) approve the Inter-Utility Service Agreement with Southern California Gas Company for the Mobile-Home and Multi-Family Energy Efficiency Program, for a term through June 30, 2028, in the annual amount of \$800,000 for a total contract amount of \$1,600,000; and (2) authorize the City Manager, or their designee, to execute the Master Inter-Utility Agreement with Southern California Gas for Energy Efficiency, Resource Savings, and Related Activities, including making non-substantive changes. The motion carried unanimously.

ENERGY EFFICIENCY AND PUBLIC BENEFITS FUNDS COMMUNITY WORKING GROUP EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS - BOARD'S PREFERRED SPENDING PLAN FOR PUBLIC BENEFITS ENERGY SURCHARGE FUND AVAILABLE RESERVES

Following discussion, it was moved by Board Member Goldware and seconded by Board Member Wright to (1) receive a presentation on the outcome of the Energy Efficiency and Public Benefits Funds Community Working Group and discuss the options for the expenditure of the funds as recommended by working group members; (2) provide staff with direction on the Board's preferred spending plan for the Public Benefits Energy Surcharge Fund available reserves to forward to the City Council for consideration; (3) recommend that the City Council (a) receive a presentation on the outcome of the Energy Efficiency and Public Benefits Fund Community Working Group and Board recommendations; and (b) approve the preferred spending plan for the Public Benefits Energy Surcharge Fund available reserves. The motion carried with Chair Siana, Vice Chair Wohlgemuth, and Board Members Wright, Goldware, Rand, Evans, and Becker voting aye and Board Member Montgomery voting no.



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REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL 2494 - PROFESSIONAL CONSULTANT SERVICES AGREEMENT - WATER COST OF SERVICE ANALYSIS AND RATE DESIGN

Following discussion, it was moved by Board Member Goldware and seconded by Board Member Wright to recommend that the City Council (1) approve a Professional Consultant Services Agreement from Request for Proposal 2494 for Water Cost of Service Analysis and Rate Design with Carollo Engineers, Inc., Riverside, California, through December 31, 2027, in the amount of \$271,960; and (2) authorize the City Manager, or designee, to execute the Professional Consultant Services Agreement and optional two-year extension, if necessary, including making minor, non-substantive changes. The motion carried unanimously.
