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RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION FOR, AND ACCEPTANCE OF ANY FUNDS FROM, THE PROHOUSING INCENTIVE PROGRAM ROUND THREE PROGRAM ADMINISTERED THROUGH THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF NECESSARY GRANT DOCUMENTS BY THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Health and Safety Code 50470 et. Seq, the State of California

Department of Housing and Community Development (the "Department") is authorized to issue

Guidelines as part of an incentive program (hereinafter referred to by the Department as the

Prohousing Incentive Program or "PIP"); and

WHEREAS, in response to the program guidelines, the City desires to submit a PIP grant

application package ("Application"), on the forms provided by the Department, for approval of grant

funding for eligible activities toward planning and implementation activities related to housing and

community development as a result of meeting eligibility criteria including but not limited to

Prohousing Designation; and

WHEREAS, the Department has issued Guidelines and Application on August 15, 2024, in the

amount of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) for PIP; and

WHEREAS, the City has an active housing production program that strives to provide

residential units for all income types of municipal residents; and

WHEREAS, on August 22, 2023, the City was notified by the Grantor that it had been

designated as a "Prohousing Designated Jurisdiction"; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that it is in its best interests to submit an application for

grant funds to facilitate future housing development that serves low to moderate income residents; and

WHEREAS, the City shall submit an application to the Grantor to participate in the Grant

Program and for an allocation of funds not to exceed One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) ("Grant

Award") for projects that accelerate housing production, create equitable and sustainable communities,

and dismantle exclusionary land use policies; and

WHEREAS, the Department may award and allocate funds greater than One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) to the City for projects that accelerate housing production, create equitable and sustainable communities, and dismantle exclusionary land use policies; and

WHEREAS, the City is familiar with the terms, conditions and limitations of any such grant; and

WHEREAS, the City is willing and able to conform to each of the terms, conditions, and limitations imposed upon any such grant to the City; and

WHEREAS, the Grantor must approve said application and will require the City to execute a Funding Agreement and other necessary documents upon approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, as follows:

Section 1: That the City Manager, or his designee, are hereby authorized to submit and execute a PIP grant application for and on behalf of the City of Riverside for an amount not to exceed One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000), and if the Application is approved, are hereby authorized to execute, and deliver on behalf of the Applicant, a State of California Agreement (Standard Agreement) for the requested \$1,000,000 in grant funds and any additional funding that may be awarded by the Grantor, and any and all other documents required or deemed necessary or appropriate to evidence and secure the PIP grant, the Applicant's obligations related thereto, and all amendments thereto

Section 2: The City Council of the City of Riverside hereby agrees to, and by this Resolution does, accept the grant funds for the requested One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000), and/or any greater or lesser amount of funds awarded by the Grantor, if such funds are awarded to the City of Riverside under the Prohousing Incentive Program Round 3 Program.

Section 3: The City of Riverside hereby agrees to comply with each and all of the terms, conditions, and limitations imposed by the Department upon said grant approval. The Application and any and all accompanying documents are incorporated in full as part of the Standard Agreement. Any and all activities funded, information provided, and timelines represented in the Application will be enforceable through the fully executed Standard Agreement. Pursuant to the Guidelines and in conjunction with the terms of the Standard Agreement, the Applicant hereby agrees to use the funds
