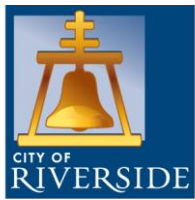
The minutes of May 27, 2026, were approved as presented.

Review Code of Ethics and Conduct



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The Community Police Review Commission reviewed the Code of Ethics and Conduct presentation from Tola Perkins and did not have any recommendations.

Extension of Racial and Identity Profiling Act (RIPA) Ad Hoc Committee duration through October 2026

Following discussion, a motion was made by Commissioner Teichert and seconded by Commissioner Lundy to extend the RIPA Ad-Hoc Committee for an additional six months, through January 2027, with the same committee members, the motion also directed the Ad-Hoc Committee to meet in person with the Police Department to gain a better understanding of the RIPA stop data. Upon completion of its review, the Ad-Hoc Committee will report its findings and any recommended changes to the commission for further discussion.

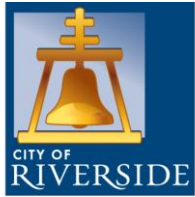
CITY ATTORNEY REPORT ON CLOSED SESSION ACTIONS
