## ORDINANCE NO. 1 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING 2 SECTION 2.08.020 AND ADDING SECTION 2.09.040 OF THE RIVERSIDE 3 MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING THE OFFICE OF THE INSPECTOR GENERAL AS AN ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE AND DEPARTMENT OF THE 4 CITY AND RETENTION OF OUTSIDE COUNSEL BY THE INSPECTOR GENERAL 5 6 The City Council of the City of Riverside does ordain as follows: 7 Section 2.08.020 of the Riverside Municipal Code is amended as follows to Section 1: 8 add Subdivision R: 9 "Section 2.08.020 Offices, departments, divisions of departments, and office/department 10 heads established. 11 The following departments and department heads are established: 12 A. The City Manager's Office, the head of which shall be the City Manager; 13 14 The Marketing and Communications Department, the head of which shall be the Marketing O. 15 and Communications Director. 16 The Office of the Inspector General, the head of which shall be the Inspector General." Section 2: Section 2.08.040 of the Riverside Municipal Code entitled "Retention of 17 Outside Council by the Inspector General" is added as follows: 18 "Section 2.08.040 - Retention of Outside Council by the Inspector General. The City Attorney, 19 or his or her designee, shall serve as a resource to the Inspector General to assist them in all matters 20 of law pertain to their office. Use of outside legal counsel in lieu of the City Attorney to advise the 21 Inspector General on specific matters shall be at the discretion of the City Council. If outside legal 22 counsel is so desired by the Inspector General and approved by the City Council, the City Attorney 23 shall contract with the appropriate party(ies)." 24 Section 3: The City hereby finds that this ordinance is not subject to review under the 25 California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines sections 15060, 26 subdivision (c)(2) (the activity will not result in a direct or reasonably foreseeable indirect physical 27 change in the environment) and 15061, subdivision (b)(3) (there is no possibility the activity in 28

1	question may have a significant effect on the environment). In addition to the foregoing general
2	exemptions, the City Council further finds that this ordinance is categorically exempt from review
3	under CEQA under the Class 8 Categorical Exemption (regulatory activity to assure the protection of
4	the environment), CEQA Guidelines section 15308.
5	Section 4: The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this ordinance and cause
6	publication once in a newspaper of general circulation in accordance with Section 414 of the Charter
7	of the City of Riverside. This ordinance shall become effective on the 30th day after the date of its
8	adoption.
