SUBJECT: RIVERSIDE PUBLIC UTILITIES SAFETY UPDATE ON INJURIES & VEHICLE ACCIDENTS

This update on the Riverside Public Utilities (RPU) Safety Program highlights the department's strong emphasis on the safety of all RPU's team members. RPU considers safety to be essential for success in accomplishing our mission. Through our values of teamwork, integrity, professionalism, and safety, the Safety Team, with the support of the RPU Executive Team, promotes a strong safety culture at all levels of RPU. The RPU Safety Team has clear objectives and effective processes and shares information using an improved safety dashboard to support safety. RPU strives to ensure that all team members have the necessary knowledge, skills, and support to work safely by providing tools, training, and programs throughout the year.

RPU has provided updates on OSHA Reportable Incident Rate, Recordable Vehicle, Equipment, and Property Incidents. The RPU Safety Enhancement Program Committee is tasked with reviewing these metrics regularly and developing objectives to improve our performance as measured by them. Developing leading metrics, such as training hours, frequency of tailboard meetings, and safety audits, will require us to create uniform processes and recording across the department.
